A Lesson In Pump Design....A, B, C or D?

The year 2020 finds us with completed pump design changes made in order to meet the updated efficiency regulations instated by the Department of Energy. Because of these changes, when helping a customer find the correct parts for a Taco FI, CI or KV pump, or when quoting a complete pump replacement for one of these models, we ask the question, "What pump design do you have?" Often the response is, "I'm not sure. How do I determine that?" There is frequently confusion about where the design character lies within the pump nomenclature.

- In the FI pump nomenclature, the character for the design code A, B, C or D is located in the 15th position, just before the characters that identify the motor code. An example would be: FI1509E4CAH1L0CB1968D
- For the CI or the KV pumps, the character for the design code is in the 11th position. CI2009E2JA**D**C730D For example: Again, just before the motor code. KV2011AB2KAB721M

The pump curves and dimensions can vary with each design, so knowing which pump design you are working with is important in making proper parts selections. When looking for a complete replacement for a specific model, knowing the design you are replacing will help in understanding if piping adjustments will be required. Impeller sizes may also differ in order to make the pump run at the most efficient point.



These changes in pump design require more careful attention when making decisions on replacement parts and complete pump replacements. As always, Kim and Shannon in the TDC are happy to assist if you need further help!
